The Earthdata website brings together and promotes Earth Science data and information from the Earth Observing System Data and Information System (EOSDIS) community including 12 data centers/Distributed Active Archive Centers (DAACs), Science-Investigator led Processing Systems (SIPS), a data and service access client (Reverb), dataset directory (Global Change Master Directory - GCMD), near real-time data (LANCE), and a host of center-unique tools for functions such as searching and subsetting data.
